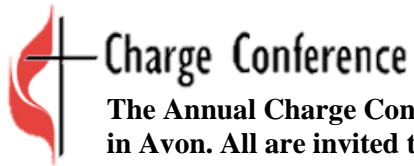
Weekly Bible Study
