Sermon Summary:

The Story of Mary & Martha. As we continue the series on Building our Relationship with God, we place this story within its context. It becomes clear that Jesus isn't saying that we ought to give up serving and become monks on a hillside removed from the world.

- 1. Martha wasn't doing anything wrong in her serving. She had lost her bearings, her sense of priorities. She'd become so caught up in her busyness She could no longer see anything except what was immediately in front of her.
- 2. Jesus isn't setting prayer and Scripture reading over and against Christian service and action. Rather, in this text, our Lord reminds us in this **both/and.** What should come first? We need to stop and listen to the voice of God.
- 3. The radical teaching of Jesus is that it's in the midst of our most frenzied time of activity that we need to stop and listen.
