## Sermon Summary:

Dietrich Bonhoeffer wrote in his book Life Together, "It is part of the discipline of living that we must not spare our hand where we can perform a service AND that we do not assume that our schedule is our own to manage, but allow it to be arranged by God."

- 1. Jesus sends 70 or 72 disciples into the neighboring towns & villages
  - a. Take no money or suitcase: Trust in me to provide
  - b. Enter a home & stay with them: Allow their hospitality to be given
  - c. Heal the sick & proclaim the Good News: Tell them about You & Me
  - d. When the 70/72 returned, they were ESTACTIC
- 2. Isaiah said, "Here I am. Send Me!"
