Sermon Summary:

Dietrich Bonhoeffer wrote in his book Life Together, "It is part of the discipline of living that we must not spare our hand where we can perform a service AND that we do not assume that our schedule is our own to manage, but allow it to be arranged by God."

1. Jesus sends 70 or 72 disciples into the neighboring towns & villages
 - a. Take no money or suitcase: Trust in me to provide
 - b. Enter a home & stay with them: Allow their hospitality to be given
 - c. Heal the sick & proclaim the Good News: Tell them about You & Me
 - d. When the 70/ 72 returned, they were ESTACTIC
2. Isaiah said, "Here I am. Send Me!"
