\*Prayer: If you would like someone to pray with you, feel free to come to the front during the closing song. Our pastor and lay prayer partners will appreciate the opportunity to join with you in prayer.

**Short Summary:** This lesson is about prayer and the universal mission of Christian faith. Some have turned the church inward and made it exclusive. Paul urges his readers to pray for all people.

1. Prayers include **praying for kings and rulers** who may be, in fact, persecuting the church. Romans 13, Revelation 13 and 1 Peter 2:13-17 tell us that the church's relationship to rulers was in serious trouble.
  - a. Paul states, 1) pray for the rulers, maybe they won't accuse us of disloyalty & we can lead a peaceful life; 2) God really wants all people, including rulers, to be saved.
2. **Knowledge of the Truth** ("accepting the truth of the faith received from the prophets"): Verses 3-4, God's intention for all to be saved. God wants all people to be saved, but does not force us if we choose not to be
