- 2. As Elijah runs in fear, God stills provides for him. "Get up and eat, otherwise the journey will be too much for you." In our journeys, we too need the provisions God provides. Otherwise the journey will be too much for us too! Will we open ourselves today to receive that which God provides for our journey?
