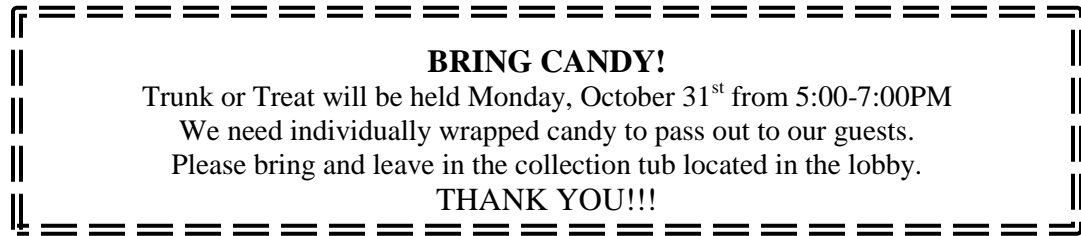
**NURSERY** is offered during all service times including Sunday School and is located on the first floor. **Need help finding our nursery?** Please ask one of our ushers for assistance.

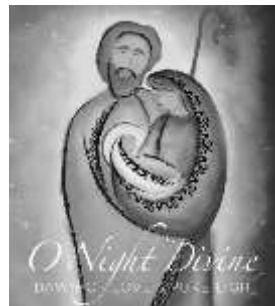
**CHANCEL CHOIR** will meet this Thursday at 7:00 PM.
