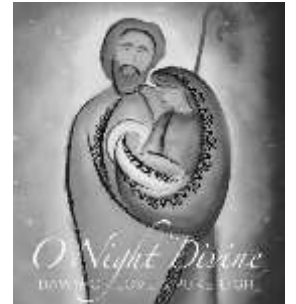
CHANCEL CHOIR will meet this Thursday at 7:00 PM.
