

Short Sermon Summary:

The overturning of enmities in the natural order breaks ground for a wilderness prophet who shakes up privileged orders with calls to repentance. God raises the banner of hope for all to follow, and a little child leads the way.

In **Matthew 3:1–12**, John the Baptizer testifies to the nearness of God's coming realm. That hope accompanies John's call to repent. John's repentance insists on integrity between faith and living
