## **Short Sermon Summary:**

Fourth in a four-part series on God's vision for Mount Olivet.

Passionate disciples; Unified by the Spirit; Nurture all people in spiritual growth.

1. The areas we want to help all people grow include: prayer, study, witness, service, and faith.
