Short Sermon Summary:

Second in a four-part series. Jesus is looking for disciples who are seriously passionate: People who will love God with their whole hearts. Passion is the driving force in our spirit that shapes our lifestyle, our thinking and our action, until we see a total fulfillment of what we are passionately pursuing.

1. **Disciples have a passion for God.** Psalm 84:2 tells of about a longing, a passion, to be in relationship with God. Ps 84:10 carries this passion further by sharing that we would rather have a menial job , a doorkeeper, if only we can be in the presence of God
2. **Disciples have a passion for people:** John 1:41” The first thing Andrew did was to find his brother Simon and tell him, “We have found the Messiah”
3. **Disciples have a passion for whatever Jesus is excited and passionate about.** A passionate disciple is “all in” with Jesus. We hold nothing back.
