Short Sermon Summary:

3rd in five-part Epiphany Series **A Disciple's Walk.**

Our lesson for today includes some of the “hardest sayings of Jesus.” Each mini-lesson follows a formula – a statement from the law, a reinterpretation moving from the results back to the motivation and attitude, to some startling challenges.

1. In each saying, Jesus calls us to base our behavior, not on conformity to outer expectations – from law, custom, religious teaching – but on the integrity of character rooted in our relationship with God.
2. How can I participate in growing my relationship with God and other people?
3. Does our culture see something special in us that they wish to experience in their lives?
