## **Short Sermon Summary:**

2nd in five-part Epiphany Series **A Disciple's Walk.**

Today's lesson focuses on the marks of discipleship beginning with salt losing its saltiness. Salt loses its flavor by being diluted or absorbing impurities, so it no longer serves its intended purpose. In the Hebrew tradition salt stands for sacrifice, loyalty, a shared relationship, purification, seasoning, and preservation. Salt does not serve itself, but exists to enhance others.

Light accentuates the promise to the disciples that the Kingdom's secrets have been revealed to them in Jesus. We are not the light, we are a reflection of the light. Disciples shed light on the world around them. How are we salt and light in our corner of the world?

Walking in the light brings glory to God. What does it mean to walk in the light so that God is glorified?
