Short Sermon Summary:

Max Lucado once asked an interesting question, “couldn’t God have thought of something better to compare us to instead of sheep? Probably not.” In John’s Gospel Jesus describes our relationship as sheep. Not the most flattering description I heard of myself recently but quite appropriate. The important point is we have a SHEPHERD! His name is Jesus!

Three important items for us sheep!

1. Hear the voice (v 3)
2. Know and follow the voice (v 4)
 - a. Sheep hear, know and follow (v 4)
 - b. Sheep hear one who knows them! (v 27)
3. Voice gives abundant life (v 10)
 - a. give them eternal life, they never perish (v 28)
