Sermon Summary (11 am)

The rather forced yet forceful dichotomy Paul constructs between law and faith functions to force that cover-up smile off our faces. As Paul preached that faith alone brought Abraham to righteousness, the apostle rejected all human attempts to get right with God through the works of the law. The outward appearance of work is useless, Paul argued, without the inward infrastructure of faith.
