## **Sermon Summary**

Our story begins on Friday morning as a gruesome execution takes place. This execution is designed to take from the executed any semblance of human dignity and take from the family any sense of humanity or hope. The execution ends in a timeframe that did not allow for proper preparation of the lifeless body for burial.

- 1. On the first day of the week, friends, Mary Magdalene, Joanna, Mary and possibly others, return to prepare the body for burial. Things are not as they should be.
- 2. As the women attempt to tell the disciples of Jesus what they have found, the disciples know the story is false. "But the words seemed to them an idle tale." "April Fool's"
- 3. The Greek word translated idle is not the word for rumors or chit-chat. It is the Greek word for nonsense, absurd, foolishness, of no usefulness. "April Fool's"
- 4. Our culture still believes the story of Easter is an Idle Tale. "April Fool's" We can only convince our world of the difference, one person at a time.
