### Short Sermon Summary:

As we enter this Season after Pentecost, we encounter again the God who creates and delights in us, loves us, frees us, and calls us into discipleship. The text invites us to explore images of God: Creator, Wisdom, Savior, Spirit who guides into all truth. As we explore who God is, we rejoice in God's world and work with God to care for creation.
