#### Short Sermon Summary:

**Short Summary:** In Luke 8:26–39, Jesus visits a gentile region and meets a person possessed by demons. On the way there, Jesus has calmed the lake storm. Now he calms the troubled man. The man is quieted, and God is found again in the silence. The man would like to go with Jesus, but Jesus sends him to take up his discipleship in everyday life.

1. In the busyness of my life, I need calm. Moments to sit and think. Moments to sit and rest. Moments to sit. Jesus brought calm to one possessed. What can Jesus do for my life?
2. In the excitement of new life, the man wanted to go spend his time, sitting at the Master's feet. While this would have been a great time for him, Jesus reminded him that as new creations, his service to God would be in the everyday lives of the people around him.
3. His service may look a lot like his old life but people will see that something different in him and they will want to know more. In those discussions, the mission of the church will include more new people. More lives will be changed.
