2019 Budget - \$607,988.00 Received Nov. 10, 2019 - \$10,055.00

Our budget is a road map of what we believe we will need in mission and ministry for the year.

The **real numbers** tell a bit of a different story of how we are doing in mission and ministry.

As of the end of September 2019, we had collected \$402,979.35 and spent \$425,527.58.

That is a **difference of -\$22,548.23**. Based on the budget breakdown, we should have spent more by this point in the year if it was needed. Keep in mind also we have not been fully staffed all year and so that has also led to a decrease in spending. I want you to know how blessed we are with a great staff and ministry team leaders here at Mount Olivet that work very hard at keeping expenses down each month. What this shows is the staff and ministry teams of Mount Olivet are prayerfully and mindfully good stewards of God's tithes and your offerings.
