From the Pastor's Desk

This October let us thank God for our roots. To be sure, we thank God that, as members of our Lord's church, we have "received Christ Jesus the Lord, walk in him, and are rooted and built up in him" (Col 2:6-7). We also thank God for rooting us in a congregation that is rooted in the teaching of **Grace alone**, **Faith alone**, and **Scripture alone**. In short, we thank God for rooting us in **Christ alone**. These were the marks of the Reformation, which we celebrate on October 31st. But what do they mean?

Grace alone: At the center of the Christian faith is the assurance that salvation is based on the unearned free gift of God's grace. Though we are sinners, disobedient children, deserving of God's wrath and anger, we receive the riches of his love and forgiveness. Faith alone: God's gift of grace is received through faith in what Jesus has done for us. Our good works and the good things that we do flow out of having a right relationship with God, but these good things do not have the power to make us right with God. Scripture alone: The Bible is the inspired Word of God. It alone is the source for what we believe and what we practice in the Christian church. Christ alone: Our basis and assurance of salvation is the person of Jesus Christ, his life, death, and resurrection.

UMC Book of Discipline Required Committees

Our UMC Book of Discipline requires that each church in the UM system have certain committees in order to maintain the functionality of each church. Here's a quick look at each and what they do.

Trustees: Functions as Christian stewards of property God has entrusted to the congregation. This includes supervising and maintaining both the physical property of the congregation and gifts made to the congregation so that the ministries of the congregation can be effective and all legal requirements related to the property are satisfied. Finance: This committee proposes a budget; then raises, manages, and distributes the financial resources of the congregation to support and strengthen the mission and ministry of the congregation.

SPRC: Staff Parish Relations Committee proactively council with and advise Pastor and Staff on their performance. The SPRC builds a strong positive relationship among the Pastor, staff, and the congregation to help make disciples of Jesus Christ. Contact Chair Carol Nease for details




What an AWESOME day for FCA @MHS!
