

UMC Book of Discipline Required Committees

Our UMC Book of Discipline requires that each church in the UM system have certain committees in order to maintain the functionality of each church. Here's a quick look at each and what they do.

Trustees: Functions as Christian stewards of property God has entrusted to the congregation. This includes supervising and maintaining both the physical property of the congregation and gifts made to the congregation so that the ministries of the congregation can be effective and all legal requirements related to the property are satisfied. Meetings are open to anyone to attend. Contact Chairman Warren Blackburn for details.

Finance: This committee proposes a budget; then raises, manages, and distributes the financial resources of the congregation to support and strengthen the mission and ministry of the congregation.

SPRC: Staff Parish Relations Committee proactively council with and advise Pastor and Staff on their performance. The SPRC builds a strong positive relationship among the Pastor, staff, and the congregation to help make disciples of Jesus Christ. Contact Chair Carol Nease for details

Administrative Board: This group is made up of the chairpersons/ members of the church committees, and is the final stop for most matters affecting the church. Meetings are open to anyone to attend. Contact Chairman Chris Seawell for details.

I wanted to make you aware of a new initiative we will be starting here at Mt Olivet. It's called "Service Sunday", and is an idea brought to us by Jennifer Phillips. I

In any month in which there is a 5th Sunday, those that want to participate will arrive at church in "work clothes", and after a worship time of 30 or 45 minutes, "work teams" will disburse inside and outside of the church to perform acts of service.

What might that look like? We could have a team stay at the church and prepare casseroles to be frozen and then taken to those in need. Nathan could take a team out to Peak to sing for them. I could take a group with me to Spring Arbor and have a time of worship and communion. A team could go out and help with yardwork, or home repair, at the home of one of our members or neighbors in need. Don't forget: "Devotions and Discs" every Monday, 5:30pm, at the Ace Run course on the North End!








If you missed "All In" Sunday, and need a blessed backpack tag, steeple sticker, or "Christ is my Anchor" bracelet, we have extras at the church!
